Purpose:

The purpose of this Customer Service Bulletin is to communicate a change to the Welch Allyn Connex Direct (HL7) Vitals Connectivity Interface which was made in CSM device version 1.51.

Change Description:

The change was made to add the Location ID in the patient query so a receiving application would know where the query came from. The change was an attempt to add the needed field and properly realign to the HL7 standard.

Change Details:

Patient Query:

- 1. QRD-8 is now part of QRD-7
- 2. QRD-9 (Patient ID) has been moved to QRD-8 (who field)

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- 3. QRD-10 (What Department = DEM) moved to QRD-9 (What subject)
- 4. ORD-10 now contains the device Location ID
- 5. QRD-13 now contains the Device Serial Number

Impact:

A change will be needed on the host side of the interface to adjust for the interface change.

Applications receiving a patient query can differentiate between versions below 1.51 and version 1.51 and above, and process messages as follows:

- 1. Below version 1.51
 - a. $QRD-8 = ^RD$
 - b. QRD-9 = Patient ID search ID
 - c. ORD-10 = DEM
- 2. Version 1.51 and Above
 - a. QRD-8 = Patient ID search ID
 - b. ORD-9 = DEM
 - c. QRD-10 = Device Location ID
 - d. QRD-13 = Device Serial Number

Based on these values the receiving application can determine where the patient ID is located and can adjust capturing the fields needed to execute the query.
