How is Life2000 Ventilation System different from the other devices I have used?

The Life2000 System is specifically designed to support you while you are on the move. You can use it in your home, carrying the 1-lb. ventilator with you — and you can leave your house with it too.





Does the Life2000® Ventilation System replace my stationary oxygen concentrator?

No, the Life2000 System works with your stationary oxygen concentrator in your home to make oxygen delivery to your lungs easier. Your oxygen concentrator is designed to deliver more oxygen to you, but your lungs still have to do the hard work of breathing in and out. The Life2000 System delivers the breath to your lungs, helping reduce your work of breathing and making it easier to stay active while getting the support you need.

Does the Life2000 Ventilation System replace my portable oxygen concentrator (POC)?

Typically, we begin by helping you use Life2000 System inside your home. When you are ready, we will also help you transition to using the device outside your home. Just like oxygen delivered from a stationary concentrator, when using a POC, your lungs still need to do the work of breathing, and transitioning to Life2000 System outside your home may help relieve symptoms during activity.
