С	Cleaning	<ul> <li>Device         Wipe with a nearly-dry cloth moistened with an approved cleaning solution:         <ul> <li>Warm water, liquid soap, Coverage®, Windex®, Ovation®, Hydrogen peroxide, Wex-cide®, T.B.Q.®</li> </ul> </li> <li>After cleaning, remove excess solution with a soft cloth dampened with clean water, then dry. D	Defaults	Create default settings using the PC Configurator Tool.
Ε	End Monitoring	Standby/Temporary Disconnect  1. Remove cables/leads from device.  2. Acknowledge equipment alert by pressing Select  3. At Acuity, the patient's waveform tile will turn BLUE indicating 'Standby.  4. To resume monitoring, use good lead prep/placement to apply leads, and then plug cables back into top of device.  Power down/Permanent Disconnect
